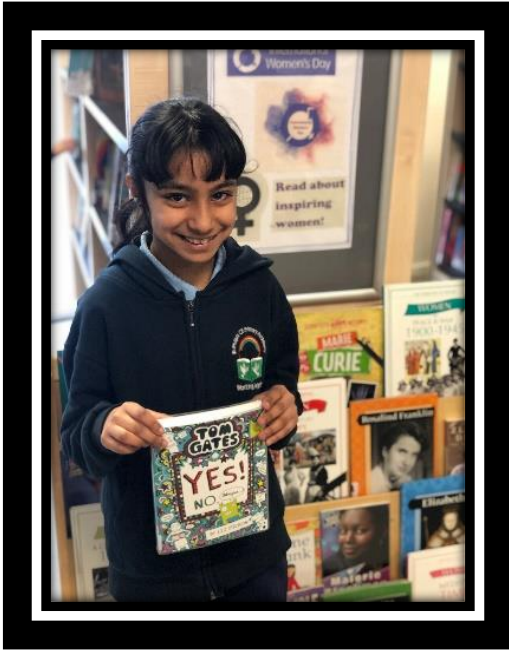
Across KS2, children are expected to keep a copy of their book on their desk at all times. Most pupils take the chance to read between lessons (spare time).

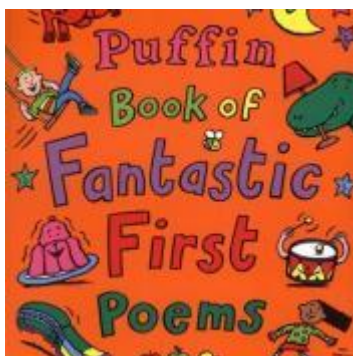
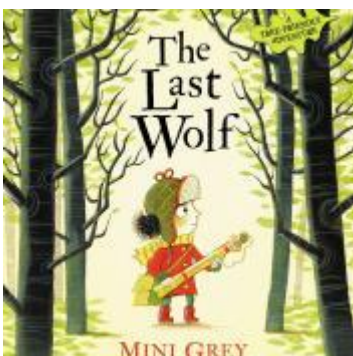
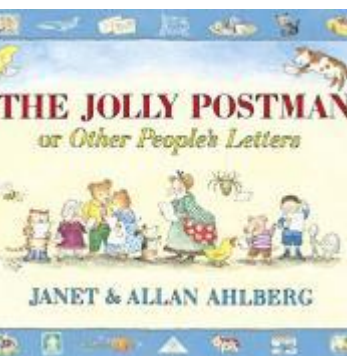
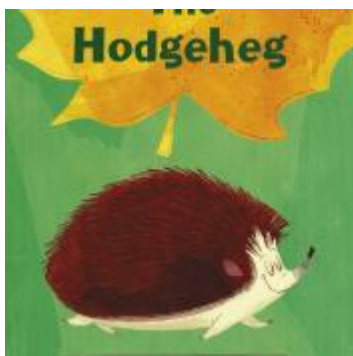
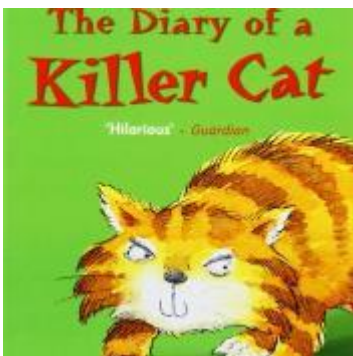
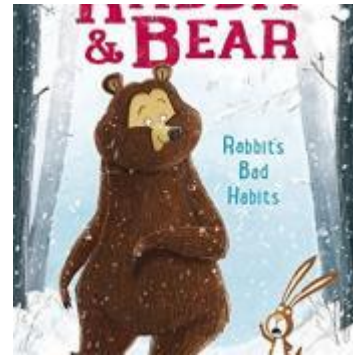
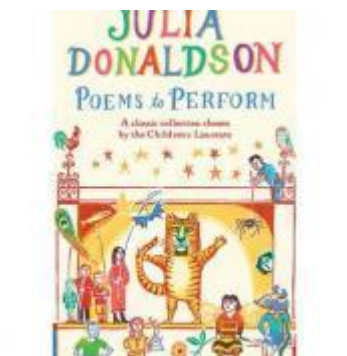
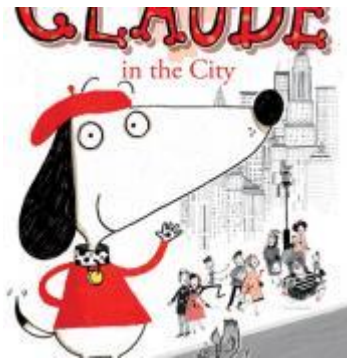
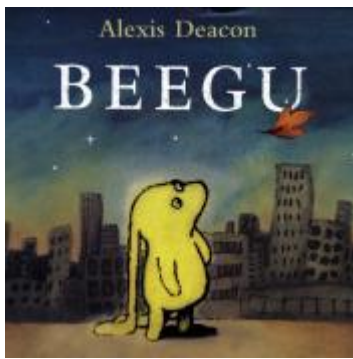
Reading Spine

Over the academic year, the children will study these key texts in class lessons and the books will also be available to promote a love of reading.

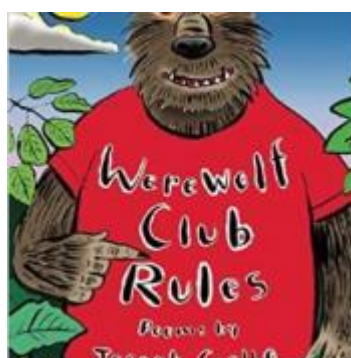
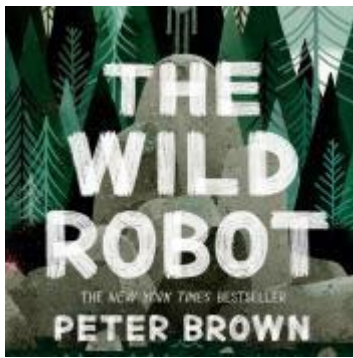
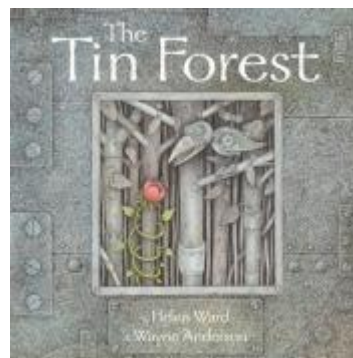
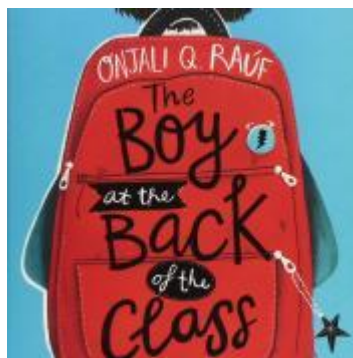
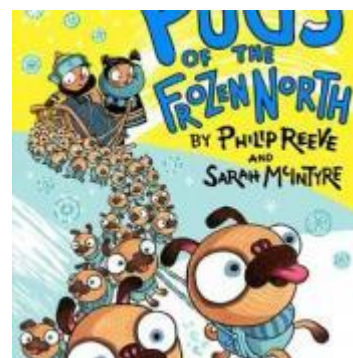
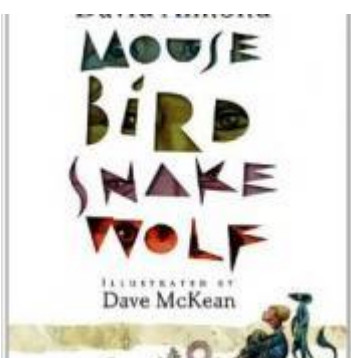
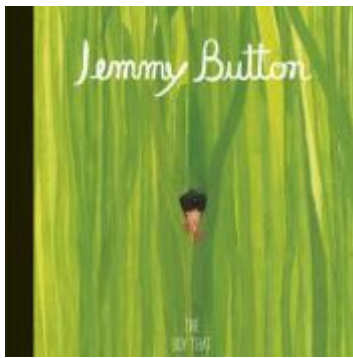
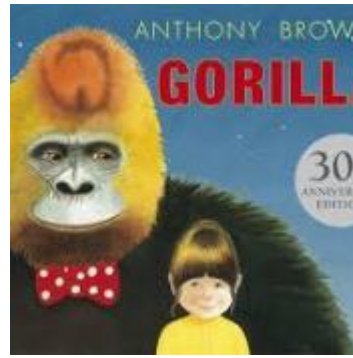
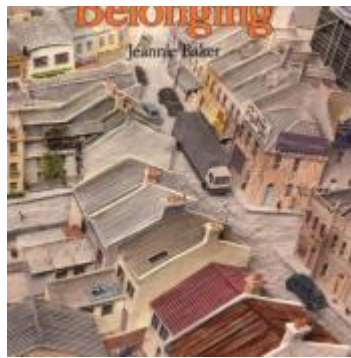
