Our learning this half term...

In Mathematics, we will be covering fractions, Money and Time. We will also continue our arithmetic skills every Friday.

In English we are reading the story Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf by David Almond. The children will be writing and conducting a balanced argument. They will also be creating their own poetry.

Our Science topic is Animals including humans. We will be looking at how important nutrition is for our bodies, what the different food categories are and how to create a healthy, balanced meal.

Reminders:

- It is important that your child knows their multiplication tables – they can practise on TTRockstars.
- PE kit on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Remind your children to change their books regularly. Our library time is Tuesday so please make sure library books are in school to be changed. There are books available at all times in the classroom.
- We expect every child to read a minimum of 3x per week for at least 20 minutes.
- Please make sure that your child is bringing in a water bottle every day.

Next half term we will be learning...

In Math we will be looking at time, shape and statistics.

The children will be reading Arthur and the Golden Rope. Arthur is a small Viking boy who is sent on an adventure.

In Geography we will be looking about the purpose of maps and how we use them. In computing, the children will be creating their own podcasts.
