Our learning this half term...

In Mathematics, we will be continuing with our journey of multiplication and division before studying measures, the measures of length and height, mass (weight), capacity (volume) and temperature.

In English we will be looking at a book by Linda Sarah and Fiona Lumbers; I can't give the title away as that is part of the excitement!

In our Science topic we will be studying animals and humans, how have a healthy lifestyle, how to care for animals and how animals benefit us as humans.

Reminders:

- It is important that your child knows their **multiplication tables – they can practise on TTRockstars**; we need to be focusing on X and ÷ of 2, 5 and 10.
- Counting forwards and backwards in 1's, 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's up to 100
- Recognise equal groups of things, books, food items,
- PE kit on **Tuesdays and Thursdays.**
- Daily 10 minutes reading of their **RWInc book, this is changed weekly; please return these.**

Next half term we will be learning...

our learning takes us further afield to the continent of Asia. In fact we will be pulling on the knowledge that the children already have in comparing the UK with Pakistan. We will concentrate mainly on the locations of Pakistan and the UK in the world and how this affects their weather and how this influences food and culture. So any information that you can share with the children over this coming time will be much appreciated.

Our art lessons will be very hands on as we're working with clay as part of our sculpture work. In PSHE we are investigating 'citizenship' and how to be a good citizen within our local community.

In RE Mrs Hussain will be teaching all about the religion of Judaism. Our computing lessons we will be looking at the internet and how we use it to search for information; and keeping safe at the same time! Finally in Music we will be studying the instruments of the orchestra, recognising which group they belong to and the noise they make.
